## MAY IS MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS MONTH

Everyone in Palm Beach County is encouraged to **wear green on May 23rd** and post pictures on social media (#GetYourGreenOn and #GYGO2019) to show their support for mental health awareness. Cities all over the county will be presenting proclamations at Commission meetings and hosting events throughout May proclaiming the importance of caring for mental health in their communities.

Important statistics to note: 1 in 4 adults and 1 in 5 youth (ages 13 to 18) experience serious mental health concerns, and 26% of children experience a traumatic event before the age of 4. Of those, 60 percent of adults and 50 percent of youth do not receive the necessary treatment due to limited or no knowledge of their mental health needs, barriers to care, or fear and shame.
