One in three U.S. families struggle to provide enough diapers to keep a baby or toddler clean, dry, and healthy.

- Diapers cost over \$107 on average every month. This is a significant cost burden on families in need.
- Federal assistance does not support diaper purchases.
- Let's come together and donate diapers or dollars to help local families in need. Collection crib is located at the front of the school.
- Left over loose diapers, new diaper cream, and wipes are needed!

Meet "Joshua". Joshua's mommy is a hardworking certified nurse assistant. She makes minimum wage and works nights and weekends so she can be home when her husband is at work. Together they make \$45,000 per year. Joshua's parents have two young children, 9 months and 2 years old. They are working hard to potty train their oldest daughter but for now, both kids need diapers. They spend approximately \$2000 per year keeping their little tush dry. This is about 4.5% of their income, enough to pay for two and a half months of groceries. Now they must choose what to purchase first.
